<b>Cannabidiol</b> (0% THC)	A key phytocannabinoid that acts on human cannabinoid receptors - Inflammation + Mood, Memory, Sleep
<b>Myrcene</b>	A key terpene that works with CBD to produce the entourage effect - Inflammation
<b>Beta-Caryophyllene</b>	A key terpene that works with CBD to produce the entourage effect - Inflammation + Mood
<b>Arnica</b>	A key herb with known medicinal properties. Most common ingredient in anti-inflammatory OTC topicals - Inflammation
<b>MSM</b> (Methylsulfonylmethane)	- Oxidative stress - Inflammation
<b>Botanical Complex</b> (Camphor-Peppermint-Eucalyptus-Menthol)	+ Cooling Effect
<b>HRT Heavy™ Pharmaceutical Base</b>	+ Tissue penetration + Systemic exposure

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### What is EB-C4?

EB-C4 is a broad spectrum transdermal cream, combined in an HRT HEAVY™ base, that drives the active ingredients into the tissue and bloodstream so they may provide benefits for the entire body. EB-C4 contains key active ingredients that are commonly used for relief, overall health, and wellness.

#### Will I get high from the CBD in EB-C4?

No. CBD is a phytocannabinoid that is non-psychoactive (it does not result in feelings of euphoria) and has a remarkable safety profile. EB-C4 is guaranteed to be THC FREE.

#### Is EB-C4 approved by the FDA?

The FDA has not evaluated EB-C4. Due to DSHEA guidelines, we cannot specifically state conditions CBD may affect. We encourage you to do your own research, consult with doctors, and use PubMed.gov as a resource as newly published research comes out in real-time. Anecdotal evidence and case reports are pushing the research needle forward, but more research is needed to provide structure and function claims associated with taking CBD.

#### Does EB-C4 need to be refrigerated?

No. EB-C4 has been formulated by licensed pharmacists to withstand separation of ingredients in high temperatures. If your shipment is received in a hot condition, simply place in the refrigerator for 15 minutes to return the consistency to a cream.

**Drug Interactions:** Do not take EB-C4 if you have any known allergies to its listed active pharmaceutical ingredients.
